Whereas several years before the death of my father, the late William R. Pickett, he gave to his grandson William R. Pickett Jr., my son, a yellow girl named Caroline, & whereas I sold the said girl, and have used the proceeds of said sale & finding that such sale & the interest in the same has amounted to near twelve hundred dollars, I do by these presents with the consent of my said son William R. Pickett give and sell to him the following slaves to re-imburse him to wit: Jacke a negro boy about sixteen and Mary Breek, a negro girl about fifteen and also moreover for the natural affection that I have for said son & also for the consideration of one Dollar to me in hand paid * give to him forever a negro boy named Josh about twelve years of age & a light Mulatto boy named Peter about four years of age, all of said slaves to be his property from this date in his own right.
